**Sound, Read, and Check**

Step 1—Sound it: Say the sounds for the letters you see.

Step 2—Blend it: Blend the sounds or groups of sounds.

Step 3—Read it: Read the word. Then read the whole sentence.

Step 4—Check it: Check to see if the word makes sense in the sentence.

Step 5—Correct it: If the word does not make sense in the sentence, blend it again.

Step 6—Reread it: Read the whole sentence again. Ask for help if it still doesn't make sense.
